Location highlights

- The Together Community is a 4 acre project, developed within Sri Shankara Colony at Hosur, near Bangalore
- Sri Shankara Colony is a 45 acre fully developed residential township located in Hosur, Tamil Nadu.
- Fully fenced and compounded areas with access roads across the development, electricity supply and street lights for the en re township, DTCP approved plots.
- Accessibility: 2.5 hours from Bangalore airport, 17 minutes from Hosur railway sta on, 25 minutes from Hosur bus stand.
- Health care and conveniences: within 25 minutes of Kauvery Hospital, 45 minutes from Narayana Hridayalaya, 20 minutes from Adyar Ananda Bhavan, Fairmart Super market.



A day in the life of our special adults

Every day in the community is well-balanced and created with the best interests and holistic development of our special adults in mind.

The daily routine includes:

Personal hygiene and grooming

The day begins with a personal grooming ritual of brushing, bathing and cleaning. Assistance will be provided as and when required.

Ample family time

The proximity ensures adequate family time through the day, during meals etc.

Movement & exercise

A daily routine that includes plenty of time in nature, walking, cycling, swimming etc.

Nutritious meals

Our special adults get nutritious vegetarian meals at the cafeteria every day: morning tea, breakfast, lunch, evening tea and dinner.

Community care

Everyone works together to ensure the welfare of our special adults. There's housekeeping, laundry, gardening and a cafeteria where our adults will be guided to work and make a positive impact.

Work, learn and interact at your own pace

Meaningful work and skill development

Data entry, manufacturing of edible products & eco-friendly products, job work, products for online sale and art and craft activities to enrich learning and promote growth.

Space for solitude

Our special adults get ample personal space to unwind, relax and enjoy their own company.

Community events & get-togethers

Festive celebrations, weekend gatherings & movies at the community hall, short trips to nearby tourist spots and visits to the Sri Shankara Colony will make the living experience more meaningful.

Recreational activities

Special adults will be encouraged to connect with family members and others through video phone calls, games and stress-free interaction.

- Furnished 300 sq. ft. individual units
- Each unit comes equipped with space for a special adult & caregiver
- Disability-friendly bathroom

- Caregiver workstations

How to apply for admission

1. For admission to The Together Community, parents are required to submit the online applica on form and meet the Directors and Trustees, online or offline.

2. The model of the community is that parents purchase and stay in the villa inside the community. They will pay a refundable deposit for allotment of studio apartment for the special adult to live in, for life me. There will be a recurring monthly fee for services that will be applicable for parents and special adults on an actual basis. The cost of individual caregiving will be applicable on a case to case basis.

3. While this community is for people with au sm, individuals with other disabili es such as Down syndrome, global developmental delay, intellectual disability will be considered for admission providing the medical commi ee approves the same.

4. Admission to The Together Community is for parents and special adults who intend to move into the community within one year of start of services. Applicable service charges will be payable from the date of commencement of services at the community/date of purchase, whichever is later.

Together Foundation runs a sheltered workshop for adults with autism and other intellectual


